



CANON JACK W. (SANDY) SMOCK

Over the last two decades, Canon Sandy Smock was committed to issues of peace with justice and interfaith dialogue in Palestine/Israel. He worked tirelessly for the Diocese of Jerusalem, making 16 pilgrimages and enabling over 800 people from the Diocese of Los Angeles to meet “the Living Stones.” During that time, Canon Sandy and his dear wife Canon Sue Smock were strong supporters of the ministry of St. Paul’s Episcopal Church, Shefa’Amr. Sandy died on January 12, 2019. A memorial service will be held for him at his home parish, Church of Our Saviour, San Gabriel, California on Saturday, February 9, 2019.
